

Below is the Authority's consolidated response to the questions raised.

The Authority is presently reviewing and consolidating feedback and public comments received by 12 December 2025. This consolidated feedback will be shared with Starlink in due course, after which Starlink will be afforded fourteen (14) days to respond.

The Authority further anticipates announcing a decision on Starlink's licence application by the end of Quarter One (Q1) 2026, following a comprehensive review process that upholds regulatory requirements and public participation. Lastly, Starlink is not licensed to operate in the Republic of Namibia.

Accordingly, the importation, possession, or use of Starlink terminal equipment and the provision of Starlink services within Namibia contravene Sections 37(1) and 38(2)(a) of the Communications Act (No. 8 of 2009) and constitute a regulatory offence in terms of Section 114(1) of the Act.
